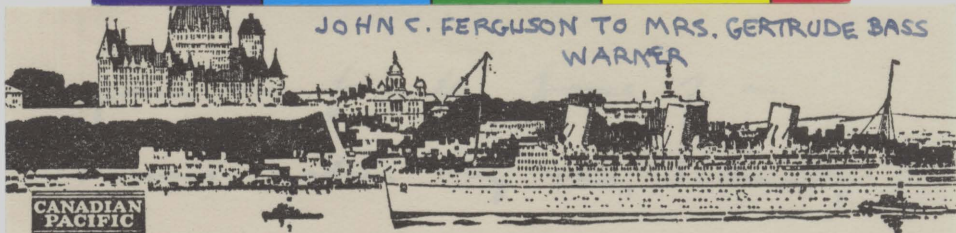

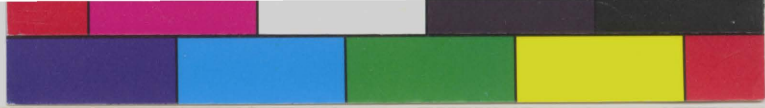

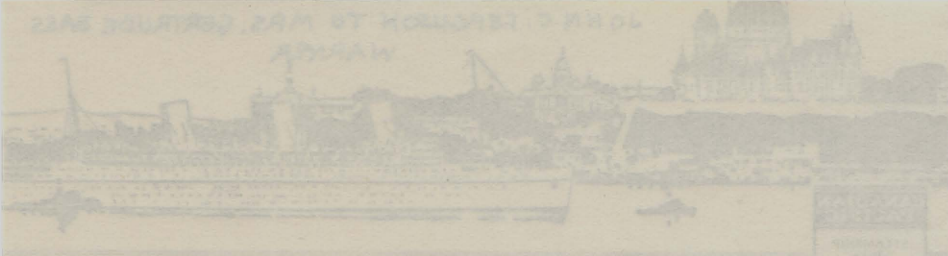
Dear Gertrude,
